
What is Climate Change?



- A change in global temperatures
- Environmental change may have a natural impacted by human activity
- One major impact on environmental change is greenhouse gasses in the atmosphere which includes the burning of fossil fuels for heating energy generation

Impacts of Climate Change

- Heat Waves Which make areas at risk of extreme heat and fire.
- Heavy Precipitation Heavy downpours are becoming more common in many locations.
- Sea-Level Rise Warming and damaging seas and oceans.





Impacts of Climate Change

- Threats to Habitats and Animals As temperatures warm, many plants and animals are migrating, making it difficult to adapt to new habitats.
- Ocean Acidification Make it difficult for corals and microorganisms to survive, disrupting the food supply for other animals.
- Wildfires Wildfires can destroy homes and be deadly.
- Drought Warmer temperatures can increase water demand and evaporation, stressing water supplies.
